12/19	Larceny	Grand Island Blvd.	Deputies responded and are investigating a report of three shoplifting events over a period of several days. Video evidence collected. Ongoing investigation.
12/19	Road Rage/ Criminal Mischief	Baseline Rd. @ Grand Island Bd.	Deputies were dispatched to a possible road rage incident. The complainant reported that a driver from another vehicle broke their vehicle side mirror. The offender vehicle fled and could not be located.

12/20	Fire Investigation	Morningside Dr.	Deputies responded to a reported fire alarm. Smoke was noticed and entry was made. Fire investigation by Erie County Sheriff's Office Fire Investigators.
