



## Erie County Sheriffs Office Media Release Summary

The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 139 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents on Grand Island.

11/15	Waterford Pk.	Accident Hit & Run	The complainant states that sometime during the night an unknown vehicle drove over his and a neighbor's lawn causing minor damage.
11/15	East River Rd.	Traffic Arrest	Following a traffic stop, Deputies arrested 32 y/o John Barber of North Tonawanda for Aggravated Unlicensed Operation 2 <sup>nd</sup> Degree (Misdemeanor) and other traffic infractions after a DMV check showed his license was currently suspended. Barber was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court.
11/15	Staley Rd.	Deer Struck	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident involving a deer. No injuries were reported.
11/15	Grand Island Blvd.	Suspicious Person	The complainant states that a male subject was walking down the roadway and yelling at passing cars. Deputies located the male and transported him to his residence.
11/15	Grand Island Blvd.	Loud Music	The complainant states that a neighbor was playing loud music in his apartment complex. Deputies located the source of the music and advised the subject.
11/15	Stony Point Rd.	Accident Hit & Run	The complainant states that sometime in the last hour an unknown vehicle struck his mailbox and fled the scene.
11/15	Grand Island Blvd.	Loud Music	The complainant states that a neighbor was playing loud music in his complex. Deputies located the source of the music and advised the subject.
11/16	Grand Island Blvd.	Loud Music	The complainant states that a subject in the neighboring apartment was playing his TV to loud during the early morning hours. Deputies advised the subject.
11/16	Grand Island Blvd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported.
11/16	Blue Jay La.	Criminal Mischief	The complainant states that an unknown person(s) damaged his pool by putting a small hole in the side of it.
11/16	Stony Point Rd.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that she found a shirt laying on the side of the road that appeared to have blood on it. Deputies removed and disposed of the shirt.
11/16	Stony Point Rd.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that his neighbor's rear door was open and they did not appear to be home. The owners

			returned to the residence as Patrol was checking. The open door was determined to be an oversight.
11/16	Bedell Rd.	Larceny	The complainant states that sometime during the past week, a known subject stole various change from his residence. The complainant only wanted the incident documented and did not wish to pursue charges.
11/16	Bedell Rd.	Warrant Arrest	While investigating the above complaint, it was determined the complainant in the call had a warrant from the City of Buffalo. Deputies arrested 67 y/o Robert Ferloin of Grand Island, and transferred him to the custody of the Buffalo Police Department.
11/16	East River Rd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported.
11/17	West River Rd.	Youth Activity	The complainant states that a small dark colored vehicle was driving down the roadway with kids hanging on the doors during the late hours of the night. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle.
11/18	Sturbridge La.	Suspicious Vehicle	The complainant states that a suspicious vehicle was parked in the field near the end of the road. Deputies located the vehicle which was unoccupied. No persons were observed around the vehicle.
11/18	Grand Island Blvd.	Traffic Control Device	Deputies responded to a report of the traffic signal at the intersection of Whitehaven rd. was not working properly. NITTEC was notified.
11/18	Sturbridge La.	Suspicious Vehicle	The complainant states a vehicle was parked at the end of the street for the entire day. Deputies located the vehicle and determined it was the same as the complaint earlier in the day.
11/18	Love Rd.	Accident Hit & Run	The complainant states that a vehicle slid into the concrete pillars in front of 711 then fled the scene.
11/18	West River Rd.	Wires Down	The complainant states that it appeared some wires were down and sparking in the roadway. Deputies checked and determined the complaint to be unfounded.
11/18	Timber Link Dr.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that she came home and found a door to her patio open during the late evening hours. Deputies checked the residence but found no persons inside. The open door appeared to be weather related.
11/19	Stony Point Rd.	Accident Hit & Run	The complainant states that sometime in recent hours an unknown vehicle knocked over his mailbox. The same vehicle also appeared to strike several garbage cans in the area.
11/19	Bedell Rd.	Motorist Broke Down	Deputies assisted a snowmobiler whose vehicle had become disabled.
11/19	Stony Point Rd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported.
11/20	Baseline Rd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported.
11/20	Sturbridge La.	Suspicious Vehicle	The complainant states that a suspicious vehicle was parked near the end of the street. Deputies located the vehicle but no persons were observed in the area.
11/20	Whitetail Run	Animal Complaint	The complainant states that her dog was stuck underneath her shed. Deputies responded and were able to free the animal.

11/21	Majestic Woods Dr.	Suspicious Vehicle	The complainant states that a vehicle was parked at the dead end of the street. Deputies located the vehicle but no persons were observed in the area.
11/21	Grand Island Blvd.	Unwelcome Guest	The complainant states that several people were sleeping in the basement of his apartment complex and did not belong there. Deputies checked the premise but were unable to locate the subjects who had apparently left prior to the arrival of Patrol.
11/21	East River Rd.	Youth Activity	The complainant states that youths were throwing snowballs at passing cars. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the youths.
11/21	Grand Island Blvd.	Accident Injury	Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident at the intersection of Whitehaven Rd. One driver was transported to a local hospital with seemingly non-life threatening injuries.
11/21	Ransom Rd.	Larceny	The complainant states that his cell phone was stolen by an unknown person(s) sometime in the past week while he was at Grand Island High School.
