02/27	Customer Trouble	Grand Island Blvd.	Deputies responded to a report from a cab driver reporting a customer was refusing to pay for their service. Deputies mediated and both parties agreed. No charges.
03/01	Shoplifting	Love Rd.	Deputies responded to a reported shoplifting from a business. A search of the area was negative for the suspect. Deputies continue to investigate and review video footage.
03/01	Suspicious Incident	Broadway	Deputies responded to a report from a homeowner of slippers found in the driveway. Deputies reviewed video footage of the area, and a subject can be seen jogging and kicking their slippers off in the driveway about an hour earlier. A search of the area was negative for the subject.

Some vehicles were left unlocked with valuables inside. Some vehicles had valuables inside in plain view and windows were broken for access. Ongoing investigation.
