



Erie County Sheriffs Office Media Release Summary

The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 360 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents in **Grand Island**.

Date	Type	Street	Narrative
03/14	Vandalism	Amy Dr.	Deputies responded to eggs being thrown at a house overnight. Patrol was able to locate a suspect at their home. The suspect admitted to the act and an agreement was made to fix the damage.
03/14	Suspicious Person	Grand Island Blvd.	Deputies received a call from an employee of a business that there was a person, possibly homeless sleeping on the porch of the business. Patrol spoke with the subject and offered assistance. The subject stated that they would contact a friend and left the area without incident.
03/15	Neighbor Dispute	Stonypoint Rd. @ E. River Rd.	Deputies were called to a neighbor dispute over trees being cut down. There was an argument over the property line where trees are being trimmed. All parties were advised to handle civilly with a survey.
03/16	Larceny from Vehicle	Stonebridge Rd.	Deputies were called by a complainant stating that someone took their debit card from her car overnight and is using it in Buffalo. Video footage of a suspect was located, and patrol is investigating further.
03/16	Traffic Arrest	Grand Island Blvd.	Deputies initiated a traffic stop on a vehicle in a business parking lot. The driver was found to have a suspended license. The subject was processed and released on Traffic Tickets.
03/19	Fire - Other	Grand Island Blvd.	Deputies responded to a suspect that lit a fire in a business parking lot. The suspect was located and found to have an active warrant out of Niagara Falls. The subject was trespassed from the business and detained on the warrant. Deputies turned the subject over to Niagara Falls Police for warrant service.
