The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 371 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents in **Grand Island**.

Date	Type	Street	Narrative
04/25	Animal Death	Baseline Rd.	Deputies responded to a report of a vehicle versus dog accident. The dog was deceased. An extensive search for the owner was conducted with negative results. The DCO was called and retrieved the remains.
04/26	Unknown Trouble	Huth Rd.	Deputies received a report of a subject that appeared to need assistance. Upon interview the Deputies recognized the subject as a missing confused adult from Cheektowaga. Subject was turned over to family and Cheektowaga Police were advised the subject was located and safe with family.
04/26	Burglary	Marlin Rd.	Deputies received a report of a burglary with the complainant reporting several items missing from the home. Deputies completed a report and are continuing investigation.
04/27	Suspicious Vehicle	Enola Rd.	Deputies were notified of an unoccupied vehicle stuck in mud. Deputies located the vehicle and investigated. It was discovered that the registered owner's son was "doing doughnuts" and got stuck. Arrangements were made by the owner.

04/28	Missing Person	Deerwood Ln.	Deputies responded for a reported missing child. The child was quickly located hiding in the garage unharmed.
05/01	Customer Trouble	Whitehaven Rd.	Deputies were contacted by a business that they would like a subject removed from the store. The subject left without incident.
05/01	Unwelcome Guest	Whitehaven Rd.	Deputies received a report from a business a subject refusing to leave. Deputies arrived and advised the subject. Subject left without incident.
