The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 343 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents in **Grand Island**.

06/06	Fire - Vehicle	I-190	Deputies were called about a vehicle on fire on I-190. The vehicle was being test driven at the time. Vehicle was fully involved upon patrols arrival. Fire extinguished and scene turned over to State Police.
06/06	Fraud	Orchard Rd.	Complainant reported that a person stating they worked for Spectrum called and arranged the Spectrum bill payment over the phone by Target Gift Cards. The complainant complied and the person called back stating that it didn't work and needed to purchase more cards. Complainant became suspicious and called Target and verified the previous gift cards were used. Complainant realized they were being scammed. Deputies completed a police report and are investigating.
06/07	Traffic Stop/ Warrant Arrest	I-190 @ Whitehaven Rd.	Deputies initiated a traffic stop for observed traffic infraction(s). Upon investigation it was learned the driver had an active warrant out of Lockport. Subject was detained and turned over to Lockport Police and the vehicle was towed from the scene.
06/10	Loud Music	Bluepointe Ln.	Deputies received a noise complaint. Deputies located the offending party and they complied with no further incident.
06/01	Larceny	Bronson Rd.	Deputies received a call for a possible stolen jet ski from a resident's dock. A police report was completed and Detectives responded and processed the scene and are continuing to investigate.
06/11	Reckless Endangerment	East River Rd.	Deputies received a call alleging a guest at a business displayed a firearm upon leaving the business. Deputies located the subject at their home and interviewed. A police report was completed and the information is being investigated by other divisions within the Erie County Sheriff's Office for possible violations.
06/12	Fire - Other	Whitehaven Rd.	Deputies were dispatched to a lawn mower on fire while mowing a residential lawn. Patrol used their assigned fire extinguisher to mostly extinguish the fire and G.I. Fire completed extinguishing the mower.
