The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 185 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents on Grand Island.

Date	Street	Type	Narrative
5/24	Baseline Rd.	Suspicious Person	Deputies located a male subject lying down in the woods near a local business. The male stated he was reading a book while enjoying the nice weather.
5/24	Baseline Rd.	Found Property	The complainant states he found a wallet and wanted to turn it over to patrol. Deputies were able to contact the owner and the wallet was returned.
5/24	Baseline Rd.	Traffic Arrest	Following a traffic stop, Deputies arrested 25 y/o Ryan Arnold of Tonawanda for Aggravated Unlicensed Operation 3 rd Degree (Misdemeanor) and other traffic infractions after a DMV check showed his license was currently suspended. Arnold was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court.
5/24	Oakridge Dr.	Road Obstruction	Deputies located a significant amount of topsoil that had been left in the roadway. Deputies contacted the party responsible and advised him to remove the excess topsoil.
5/24	Whitehaven Rd.	Lost Property	The complainant states she lost her luggage while at Byblos Niagara Resort & Spa. The luggage was located a short time later.
5/25	Grand Island Blvd.	Suspicious Person with Vehicle	Deputies located an occupied vehicle at a closed business during the late hours of the night. The driver stated he was dropping the vehicle off for scheduled maintenance the following day.
5/25	Stony Point Rd.	Traffic Arrest	Following a traffic stop, Deputies arrested 37 y/o Stacey Cordova of Grand Island for Aggravated Unlicensed Operation 3 rd Degree (Misdemeanor) and other traffic infractions after a DMV check showed his license was currently suspended. Cordova was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court.
5/25	Bedell Rd.	Residential Burglary	Deputies responded to a report of a male subject sleeping in the roadway during the late hours of the night. Deputies located the male subject who was identified as 19 y/o William Pendrys of Grand Island and arrested him for Disorderly Conduct (obstructing vehicular traffic). Upon searching his person Deputies found various narcotic prescription pills and other suspicious

			property. The pills belonged to a resident at a nearby house and when Deputies checked the residence they found the home had been burglarized. Pendrys was further charged with Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance 7 th Degree (Class A Misdemeanor), Burglary 2 nd Degree (Class C Felony), Grand Larceny 4 th Degree (Class E Felony), Criminal Possession of Stolen Property 4 th Degree (Class E Felony) and Criminal Mischief 3 rd Degree (Class E Felony). Pendrys was transported to the Erie County Holding Center pending his arraignment in the Town of Grand Island Court.
5/25	Grand Island Blvd.	Burglary	The complainant states that sometime during the night, an unknown person(s) entered his business and stole an undetermined amount of money and NYS inspection stickers. Investigation Ongoing.
5/25	Colonial Dr. East	Reckless Operation	The complainant states that a neighbor was driving recklessly down the street. Deputies located the subject and advised him.
5/25	Grand Island Blvd.	Reckless Operation	The complainant states that a vehicle was swerving down the roadway and cutting off other drivers. The driver of the vehicle also threw a bottle at the complainant's vehicle. The complainant was able to obtain a license plate number for the vehicle. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle. Investigation Ongoing.
5/25	Broadway	Accident Injury	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident involving a bicyclist. The bicyclist was treated on scene for seemingly minor injuries.
5/25	Ransom Rd.	Animal Loose	The complainant states that a dog was running loose through the neighborhood. The Dog Control Officer was notified.
5/26	Whitehaven Rd.	Accident Injury (Deer Struck)	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident involving a motorcycle vs. deer. The driver of the motorcycle was transported to a local area hospital with seemingly non-life threatening injuries.
5/26	East River Rd.	Fireworks Use	The complainant states that she could hear fireworks in the area of her residence. Deputies checked the area but were unable to hear any fireworks.
5/26	Grand Island Blvd.	Larceny	Employees of Tops state that a male subject left the store without paying for several items. Deputies located the male subject nearby. Their investigation led to the arrest of 38 y/o Eric Wiley of Buffalo for Petit Larceny. Wiley was issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court.
5/26	Grand Island Blvd.	Larceny	The complainant states sometime in recent hours an unknown person(s) stole a license plate from his vehicle.
5/26	Bronson Rd.	Loud Music	The complainant states that a neighbor was playing loud music from his boat during the late evening hours. Deputies located the subject and advised him.
5/26	Woodstream Dr.	Pistol Permit Investigation	Deputies conducted a background investigation of a subject who applied for a pistol permit.
5/27	Whitehaven Rd.	Suspicious Person with Vehicle	The complainant states that 2 vehicles were parked in the back of the lot at Byblos Niagara Resort & Spa during

			the late hours of the night. Deputies located the vehicles which were occupied and advised the subjects who left without incident.
5/27	Fix Rd.	Larceny	The complainant states that sometime during the night, an unknown person(s) stole a trailer from his property.
5/27	Whitehaven Rd.	Wires Down	Deputies assisted the Grand Island Fire Company with a report of wires down.
5/27	Whitehaven Rd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported.
5/27	Dolphin Dr.	Marijuana Possession	Deputies responded to a report of a suspicious vehicle that was parked in the street and occupied by 2 persons during the late hours of the night. Deputies investigation led to the arrest of 2 Juvenile Offenders for Unlawful Possession of Marijuana (Violation). The Juvenile Offenders were issued an appearance ticket returnable to the Town of Grand Island Court.
5/28	Love Rd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported.
5/28	Settlers Row	Pistol Permit Investigation	Deputies conducted a background investigation of a subject who applied for a pistol permit.
5/28	Morningside Dr.	Larceny	The complainant states that sometime during the night an unknown person(s) stole a street sign from the neighborhood.
5/29	East River Rd.	Suspicious Vehicle	The complainant states that a construction vehicle was acting suspiciously driving up and down the street. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle by the description given.
5/29	Ransom Rd.	ATV Injury Accident	Deputies responded to a report of an ATV accident with an injury. One subject was transported to a local hospital with seemingly non-life threatening injuries.
5/30	Love Rd.	Accident Hit & Run	Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident in which one of the vehicles involved fled the scene. No injuries were reported.
5/30	Whitehaven Rd.	Reckless Operation	The complainant states a subject on a motorized bicycle was riding in the wrong lane of traffic. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the bike.
5/30	Carl Rd.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that 2 subjects parked a vehicle near the playground on Carl Rd. and ran into the woods. The subjects came out a short time later and left in the vehicle. Deputies located the subjects nearby and advised them.
5/30	Grand Island Blvd.	Disorderly Person	Employees at Wendy's state that a male subject began yelling and cursing while in the drive thru causing a disturbance. The subject fled the area prior to the arrival of patrol. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the subject by the description given.

Deputies responded to 11 Burglary False alarm calls and 7 Fire Alarms during the dates of this report.
