## Senn Garners MAC Weekly Accolades



### Freshman net minder earns honor in aiding Kent State's defense

**KENT, Ohio** – [Stephanie Senn](#), a freshman goalkeeper on the Kent State women's soccer team, was named the Mid-American Conference's defensive player of the week for the week ending Sept. 16.

Senn surrendered just one goal in 184 minutes of action this past weekend. The freshman goalkeeper stopped six shots, including two in overtime, as Kent State defeated Marshall 2-1 in overtime to secure the Golden Flashes best start in school history at 5-0-1. Senn also aided in the attack against Marshall, [registering](#) her second [career](#) assist in just her sixth collegiate contest.

On Sunday after Duquesne scored twice in the opening seven minutes, Senn, a native of Grand Island, N.Y., came on in relief and held the Dukes scoreless the final 78:26 making three saves in the process.

Kent State (5-1-1) begins MAC play this Friday when the Golden Flashes travel to Central Michigan.
